

## Hy9 opens new hydrogen reformer manufacturing plant

Hydrogen purifier and reformer developer Hy9 Corporation has announced that it has opened a new manufacturing facility in response to increased demand for its products.

The company says that it has increased demand from fuel cell and other industries for its process intensification technology, which allows for a one-step reforming process that provides high-purity hydrogen.

The new plant will manufacture metal membrane hydrogen purifiers designed to extract hydrogen from gas mixtures.

Commenting on the plans, Hy9's chief executive Jeffrey Altman said that he expected the new manufacturing facility to improve the company's service to its customers in the industrial and energy markets.

"We continue to pursue a focused strategy of developing and producing compelling economic as well as technical hydrogen solutions to meet the needs of our clients in the industrial, specialty gas and energy markets that demand difficult or advanced applications," Mr Altman said.

Hy9 says that it has already sold more than 600 of the hydrogen purifying systems.
